Your application is ground on 2 documents:

- the BNS Membership Application Form
- the BNS Member Identification Form

with the mention of two BNS members supporting your application.

Please also send us:

- a short CV
- a motivation letter

The BNS Membership Application Form and the BNS Member Identification Form can be downloaded from the BNS website www.bnsorg.be (home > membership). Please, take care to fill in all the fields. If you are student, indicate the college or the university where you are studying as "Professional co-ordinates". Do not forget to name two BNS members supporting your application.

Your CV will list your academic background and your professional experience (excepted for student applying) related to nuclear activities. (*rem: the CV is interesting in order to know a little bit more about you*)

In the motivation letter, please explain what is motivating your application, what you are expecting from the BNS and what might be your contribution to the BNS. (*rem: the motivation letter is interesting in order to know what are your expectations from BNS*)

Send all together these documents to the BNS secretary.

You will find the Bylaws and Rules of the BNS on the BNS website www.bnsorg.be (home > about us > structure).

Membership application acceptance

Your membership application will be presented to the next BNS Executive Committee that will decide whether it is accepted.

As soon as your application has been evaluated, the BNS secretary will notify you the Committee decision.

In case of acceptance, your data will be immediately incorporated to the BNS members list, and you will be invited by the BNS secretary to pay the BNS annual member fee such as indicated on your application.

Rem: the communication with the members is preferentially done by electronic way.
